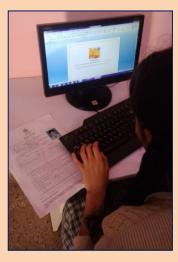

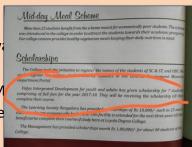






The Loyola Degree College published their first College magazine with a special note about VIDYA and the Scholarship Programme.
