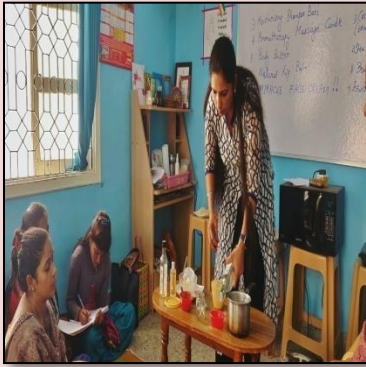
WORKSHOPS, TRAININGS & VISITS

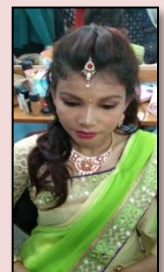

Story telling session was conducted for students on the importance of building strong communities. The session ended with a **music jam session** where the women brought in their musical instruments and created beautiful blend of music together.



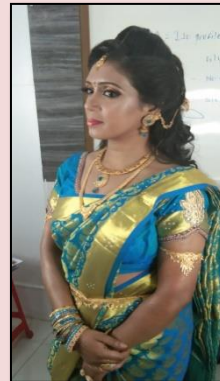
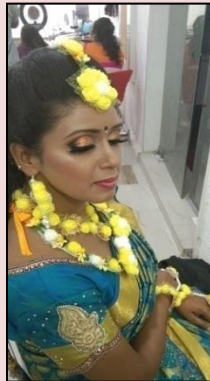
Ms Sindhura JS a celebrity makeup artist/ pro bridal makeup artist conducted a session on professional makeup techniques.

The art, the psychology, the science & skill behind parenting

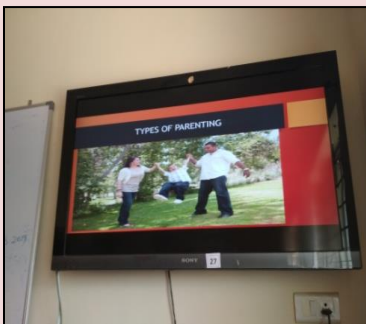
Parenting makes or mars lives and its consequences can be endearing or damaging to the children in the long run! The journey of parenting, growing together with the children as a parent, cherishing
