



Founder President, Rashmi Misra, has been honored with the Outstanding Leadership Award by NGO Leadership Award in association with World Sustainability.

As the Mumbai team firmly believes in VIDYA's mission towards holistic education, we have integrated the new NEP/ NYP policy into our educational and skill project, which leads to experiential learning, in addition to the diverse range of events, activities, and excursions.

Today VIDYA Mumbai has spread its wings and expertise to other cities as well like Pune and Goa.

We have also laid our 5-year expansion plan in a very strategic manner. The main objective is to bridge the gap in the less privileged communities through our various community development programs, like -



- 1. Bal Panchayat- Students lead initiative, helping them with decision making, critical thinking and time management. We have impacted more than 2000 + beneficiaries so far.
- Digital Saathi- Aligned under the Digital India campaign, here with the support of our alumni group we are training the women of the community to get digitally equipped. This particular initiative has been a huge success for VIDYA Mumbai as we have impacted more than 2000 women till date. We believe "there is no tool for development more effective than the empowerment of a women"
- Doing workshops for the community members and addressing the social challenges of the community—like drug abuse, girl child education, cyber crime, etc has also impacted the communities at large and the impacted families are more than 3000.
- 4. Placement cell- VIDYA Mumbai had taken this responsibility of hand holding their beneficiaries and giving them opportunity and avenues for job openings- from 140 jobs during the first year of covid to 280 in the second year and this year- 2022-23 it has reached 450.
- 5. Scholarship opportunities for all the children and youth of the community, so far we have impacted the lives of 1100+ beneficiaries, some have taken up corporate jobs and few are into civil services.
- 6. Nutrition/ Health care: VIDYA believes that "He who has health has hope; and he who has hope has everything". We have integrated the nutrition aspect across all programs and are also looking at partnering with organizations who can take the mental health aspect forward in a strong way.

At VIDYA, it is all about collaborations and partnerships. We work together with businesses, government and other non-profits in accelerating the development process at a "grassroots" level. At VIDYA, our efforts are multi-pronged and aimed towards institutionalizing truly "self-sustaining" and "value-accretive" development agendas. This most commonly takes the form of customized and curated vocational training and educational programs for our diverse communities across India. We channelize our efforts through a network of our community centers across India, impacting over thousands of lives each year. (via our direct and indirect networks).

## Programs of VIDYA India

#### 1. VIDYA School

Inaugurated in 2009, VIDYA School in Gurugram stands as the flagship project, a source of pride as it ranks among the top 10 schools in Gurugram and is recognized among the top 200 schools in all of India! It is a CBSE-accredited K-12 co-educational institution which provides high-quality school education, offering modern facilities and amenities to nurture its students.

The school caters to students from Pre-Nursery to Grade 12, with an annual enrollment of approximately 1200 students. VIDYA School's educational approach is founded on individualized attention, tailoring support to each student's unique needs and strengths. The curriculum extends beyond academics, encompassing a diverse range of sessions that foster academic growth along with cognitive and behavioral development among its students.

VIDYA School implements all CBSE learning areas and also conducts regular professional development sessions for teachers in the form of "Review & Response" meetings to ensure that the curriculum is delivered with the utmost efficiency.

Furthermore, teachers actively engage with parents through both formal Parent-Teacher Meetings (PTMs) and informal, routine communication.

#### 2. Bal Vihar School

Nestled within the historic surroundings of Panchsheel Park, New Delhi, stands VIDYA's pioneering primary school program - The Bal Vihar School. It was started in 1985, in the IIT Delhi campus, and would operate out of the amphitheater. Since then it has been serving children from lowincome households residing in the vicinity. Most of these children are first learners in their families. Here they embark on the most significant journey of knowledge and open a path to a transformed life.

Bal Vihar primary school is from nursery to grade 5, following NCERT books and learning materials. The school offers -

- Child centric learning
- Counseling sessions for students and their parents
- Nutritious meals for breakfast and lunch
- School uniforms
- Computer lab
- Playground area
- Yearly books & stationery
- Taekwondo Training
- Yoga Classes
- Music Lessons Instruments like Tabla, Drums, Guitar etc

Session 2022-23 total student enrolled-: 223

Bal Vihar students continuing in prestigious schools-

- 1 child got admission at Modern School Barakhamba Road.
- 2 children got admission in VIDYA School Gurugram.
- 9 children got admission at DAV Model School, Arya Public School, Guru Harkishan Public School, Model School and Malviya Nagar Govt. School.





#### 3. Scholarship Program

The VIDYA Scholarship Program enables meritorious students from underserved communities to pursue higher education. Scholarships support Pre-University Education, Undergraduate studies, and other Professional courses. The scholarships are made possible through collaborations with various esteemed foundations or directly provided by VIDYA after careful consideration to deserving meritorious students. Full or part scholarships are offered for PUC, ITI courses, graduate degrees in commerce, science, arts and engineering.

VIDYA educators also offer academic guidance and mentorship to these students.

Weekends at VIDYA centres are devoted to the scholarship students for remedial coaching in core academic subjects, imparting essential life skills, and offering career counseling.

The program was launched in 2012 and it has supported 500+ students to pursue higher education by disbursing more than Rs.1 Crore over the years.

## 4. NIOS Programme

The National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS) program is for Class 10 & Class 12 students, who were unable to complete their formal schooling to give Board exams. These youth have dropped out of school, some have started working due to financial constraints, and some require flexible ways of education.

NIOS accredited VIDYA centres are in Bangalore, Delhi & Gurgaon.

- Gyan Kunj, VIDYA School, Gurugram
- KV, IIT Delhi
- VIDYA Centre of Excellence, East Bangalore

A hybrid distance learning model is used across various community centres in Mumbai.

Under the NIOS board curriculum VIDYA India also offers Open Basic Education (OBE) to provide primary school education. The OBE Bridge Program is for underprivileged children to get age-appropriate education equivalent to school level. By providing flexible, accessible, and relevant education opportunities, the Open Basic Education program helps students acquire the skills and knowledge they need to improve their lives and achieve their full potential.

At VIDYA Centre of Excellence, Bangalore 17 students appeared for OBE board exams with a 100% pass rate.



## 5. 50+ Government School Partnerships

VIDYA partners with various Government schools, across the country as a knowledge partner. This is a 'Public Private Partnership' - VIDYA provides the curriculum and teaching materials along with the honorarium of the teachers; whereas the schools provide basic infrastructure - classrooms, midday meals etc for the students. The curriculum focuses on teaching spoken english, life skills, and basic computer usage.

Centres in Delhi, Mumbai, Goa, Bengaluru, Pune have grown organically and VIDYA India has created further programmes to support their needs.

## 6. Women Empowerment Programs

The Women's Program at VIDYA is a dedicated initiative aimed at women empowerment, by equipping them with diverse skills and showing them the way towards financial freedom.

- (i) Vocational training in tailoring, crochet, product making, and embroidery, are offered through a comprehensive 3-month certified course by Singer.
- (ii) Professional 6-month beautician training under the Shringar Program, with job placement support via partnerships with Urban Company and YesMadam.
- (iii) Culinary skill development with Aahar training workshops - here women learn a wide range of recipes from trained chefs, as well as managing the business aspects of catering, tiffins and community kitchens.
- (iv) With Adult literacy program Digital Saathi women are taught how to use smartphones effectively, with a focus on 'home-grown businesses and formation of Self-Help Groups (SHGs).

These multifaceted programs are designed to empower women with the knowledge and skills they need to enhance their livelihoods and achieve selfsufficiency.

Most women start their own gigs earning an average of Rs.12,000 per month and others secure jobs with monthly salaries ranging from Rs.5,000 to Rs.15,000.

The DEP program encompasses a wide range of vital digital skills to improve quality of life, enhance qualifications and employability, and promote selflearning.

## Sanskriti Program

Launched across PAN VIDYA in 2019, this program offers VIDYA students the opportunity to explore music, dance, and performing arts. It is a platform for our students to nurture their talents. We are also collaborating with accomplished artists, to mentor the students and share their extensive expertise.

#### Music:

- 10 students have been selected and will be undergoing the Carnatic music syllabus affiliated to the Bridge Academy of Fine Art and will appear for the grade exams on completion of the syllabus.
- 4 students are learning Hindustani music affiliated to the Bangiya Sangeet Parishad. They will be appearing for the first level exam.

#### Dance:

- The Kathak dance students have performed at the Medhakshetra School of Arts and Dance and participated in the Founder's Day celebration at the VIDYA School, Gurugram.
- 5 Kathak students have been selected to appear for the grade exam at the Medhakshetra School of Arts and Dance.

#### Martial Arts:

- 50 out of 200 karate students from the GMPS Puttenahalli and GHPS Arekere got the yellow belt from the World Authority Shotokan Do Association.
- 80 karate students of VIDYA Centre of Excellence are learning karate from Okinawa Shorin Ryu Do Kobudo India. 9 have got their yellow belts.

7 students participated in the 6th National Shotokan Karate Open championship conducted by Japan Karate Shotokan Academy, winning medals in two disciplines-kumite (sparring) and kata (martial art movement/form).

One of the center's most significant achievements is the provision of dedicated space for computer classes. Equipped with laptops, this space empowers students with the digital skills necessary to thrive in today's



technology-driven world. The Gyan Kunj Center also offers separate restrooms and a water cooler area, emphasizing the importance of a comfortable and conducive learning environment. Every detail has been meticulously designed to ensure that students can focus on their studies without any distractions or discomforts.

#### New Centre of Excellence in South Bangalore

In the heart of South Bangalore's Weaver's Colony, amidst various migrant colonies a new beacon of hope has emerged - VIDYA Centre of Excellence. On June 10th, 2023, VIDYA India inaugurated the COE, with promises to bring a world of educational and vocational opportunities to children, women, and youth in the area.

For women, the programs offered here encompass vocational training in stitching, beautician training, cooking, and more. The center is equipped with a variety of resources, including sewing machines, salon equipment, and a fully functional commercial kitchen.

For youth & adults, the center has a fully equipped computer lab, where computer education programs are held. Equipping youth and adults with the digital skills necessary to navigate the modern world. Additionally, communicative English training is provided, opening doors to better communication and employability.


based on the theme Madhurashtakam.

The LMS will also contain course materials to train teachers remotely. We also aspire to share our expertise and impact beyond India, with global communities.

Collaborate and expand the partnerships to 1000 Government Schools, and offer the current programmes on life skills, tuition & remedial classes. Working alongside an existing eco-system gives greater scale to the impact VIDYA India can create. The Hub will be open 24x7 for students, who do not have a dedicated space at home (as most live in a 1 room house with a family of more than 5 members) to use study classrooms and library facilities. The Hub will offer comprehensive test preparation for both undergraduate and postgraduate competitive exams - IIT-JEE, NEET, GMAT, or UPSC.

#### 5. STEM Labs & Library

STEM labs and a well-stocked library to offer hands-on experiences and a treasure trove of knowledge. A place where curiosity will be nurtured, and minds encouraged to explore and become a launchpad for the next generation of innovators.


This dream will be made possible with the generosity of our esteemed donors and patrons. We express our heartfelt gratitude to those who have contributed towards building the foundation for a physical structure.

When the news of the centre spread like wildfire through the village, excitement coursed through the air; women and children, their faces beaming with

hope, rushed to the centre on the opening day—a day that marked the beginning of a new chapter in their lives. The mere thought of gaining digital education, once a distant dream, had become a tangible reality.

Currently the Dadh DigiSkill centre has 70 students enrolled with more women and children expressing their interest each passing day.


