It has become a cornerstone of VIDYA's mission, bridging the digital divide and creating pathways to employment and entrepreneurship. Through partnerships with industry leaders and alignment with national initiatives like Viksit Bharat, the program serves as a catalyst for social change, reaching individuals from urban tech hubs to rural communities. 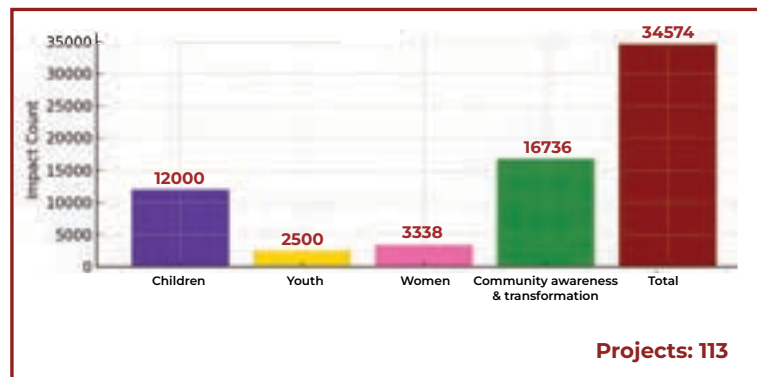

Programs for Children

VIDYA School, Gurugram

The VIDYA School in Gurugram is a CBSE-accredited K-12 institution serving over 1,200 underserved children. Known for its academic excellence, the school integrates life skills, sports, arts, and the Sanskriti program, with a focus on cultural arts. Facilities include robotics labs and IT-enabled classrooms that foster critical thinking. Nutritious daily meals support student well-being, and a dedicated focus on empowering girls promotes equal opportunities for academic and personal growth.



Bal Vihar, New Delhi

Since 1985, Bal Vihar has provided quality primary education for children from marginalized communities, aligning with the UN SDGs. Located at Panchsheel Park, New Delhi, Bal Vihar combines academics with cultural studies, life skills, and digital literacy. Its alumni have progressed to prestigious institutions, reflecting the school's long-standing impact.



School Partnership Model

VIDYA's model bridges educational gaps through partnerships with government and low-income private schools. Key initiatives include:

- ♦ **Bhavishya-Yaan:** Enhances spoken English, life skills, and digital literacy in 7 BMC Mumbai schools in partnership with Rotary Club, Bombay.
- ♦ **Public-Private Partnership:** Enriches learning in government schools via life skills and digital education.
- ♦ **Beyond School Program:** Provides English, digital skills, and remedial support in government schools.
- ♦ **School Enhancement Initiative:** The program is designed where we support the semi govt and govt schools under four verticals, mobilization strategy, teacher training, curriculum designing as well as taking the academic sessions for a span of 5-8 years to bring up the learning curve as also sustaining it for the community.
- ♦ **Samruddhi Initiative:** The program is designed where we integrate with Spoken English, Life Skills and digital literacy post school hours
- ♦ **Digital Empowerment Program (DEP):** Teaches essential computer skills, coding, and logical reasoning to prepare students for the digital future.

VIDYA Community Model

The Beyond School Program in Mumbai and Bengaluru offers after-school support, including academic reinforcement, digital literacy, and life skills in community centers. Parent engagement and partnerships with local schools strengthen outcomes, enabling first-generation learners to access higher education.



Open Basic Education

VIDYA's Open Basic Education (OBE) Program supports flexible learning for marginalized groups through the National Institute of Open Schooling (NIOS). Accredited up to Level C, VIDYA combines foundational academics with digital and life skills, enabling learners to rejoin formal education.



Beyond School Program

Beyond School is a program that runs pre and post school hours in the urban slum communities of Mumbai. It aims to support the children in education and accelerate their holistic growth. This program is structured with key aspects like academic assistance, life skills, and digital literacy.

Programs for Youth

NIOS Program

Since 1994, VIDYA's NIOS program has enabled youth, adults, and women to complete basic and secondary education, vocational training, and life skills development across five centers in India. With over 8,000 lives transformed, the program fosters personal growth and employability.



Digi Skills Program

VIDYA DigiSkill bridges academia and industry by teaching digital skills to students in grades 10–12 and career readiness to graduates. Operating across India since 2005, DigiSkill has trained 15,000 youth, empowering them for the digital workforce and closing the digital divide.



Communicative English

VIDYA's LSRW-focused English curriculum enhances listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills for youth, women, and children. Through practical activities like role-play and theater, students gain confidence, overcome language barriers, and communicate effectively.



Scholarship Program

VIDYA's Scholarship Program offers financial aid, remedial teaching, and life skills training for pre-university, undergraduate, and professional courses, with a focus on supporting female students.



Programs for Women

Livelihood Skill Training

VIDYA's Women Empowerment Program offers skills in tailoring, crochet, mehndi, beauty, and culinary arts, supported by SHGs, digital literacy, and life skills training, promoting financial independence and entrepreneurial ventures.



Margam and Self-Help Groups (SHGs)

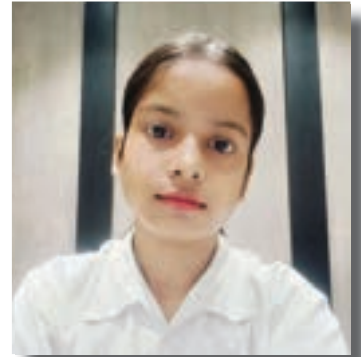

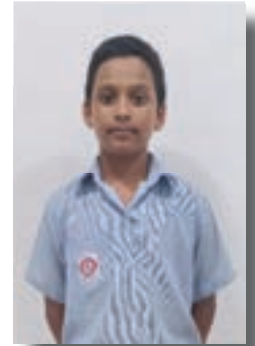


YOUTH: Educational Advancement and Sustainable Career Growth

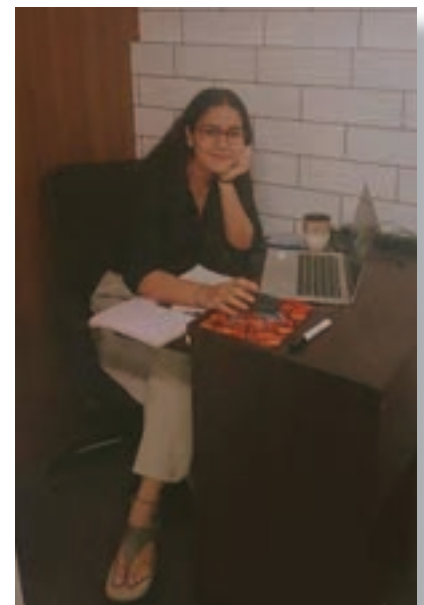

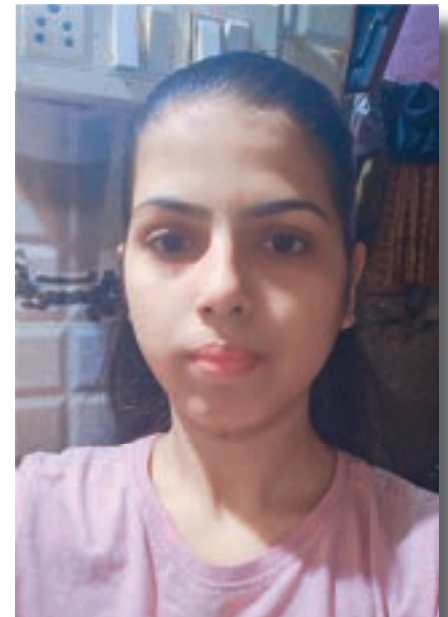


From Disengaged to Aspiring Engineer: Ritik's Transformative Journey with VIDYA

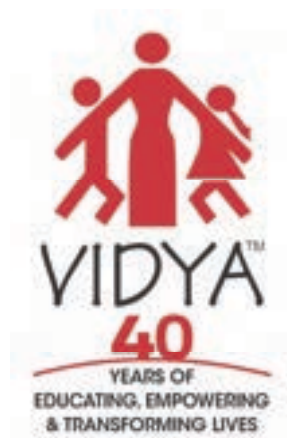




